BEIJING / HOHHOT / XILAMUREN GRASSLAND / BAOTOU / DALAD BANNER / ORDOS [CBSM]

DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR > BEIJING

Assemble at the airport for the flight to Beijing, the capital of China.

DAY 2 BEIJING - HOHHOT

[L/D]

- After lunch, take the high-speed train to Hohhot, the capital of Inner Mongolia. "Hohhot" is a Mongolian word, which means "Blue City" in Chinese. It is located in Tumochuan, central Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region. Hohhot is the capital of the region and serves as its political, economic, and cultural center. It is also a historically and culturally significant city in northern China.
- After dinner, enjoy an overnight stay in Hohhot.
- Hohhot Huachen Lvyue Hotel or similar

DAY 3 HOHHOT A XILAMUREN GRASSLAND

- After breakfast, head to the Xilamuren Grassland. Upon arrival, experience the Mongolian welcoming ceremony and partake in the tradition of drinking XiamaJiu, a Mongolian custom symbolizing the hospitality of the grassland people. Then, watch exciting grassland entertainment such as horse racing and wrestling performance while enjoying the vast and breathtaking scenery of the open grasslands.
- Next, visit the joyful pasture on the grassland, where you can experience local culture and customs by dressing in traditional Mongolian robes for photos, making milk tea, learning Mongolian, writing in Mongolian script, and making treats like candied hawthorn
- After dinner, take part in a lively bonfire party under the night sky of the grasslands, celebrating with local Mongolian hosts through song and dance, and experiencing the vibrant spirit of Mongolian culture.

DAY 4 XILAMUREN GRASSLAND A HASUHAI BAOTOU

- In the early morning, you can enjoy the grassland sunrise at your own pace.
- After breakfast, depart for Hasuhai, a scenic summer getaway known for its natural beauty and tranquil lake. Hasuhai is a natural lake, known as the "West Lake outside the Great Wall". Upon reaching the Chilechuan Grassland in the southern Hasuhai Tourist Area, visit the cultural site featuring the Sacred Genghis Khan Square and admire the towering statue at its center.
- Next, visit Huhua Aobao, a sacred site made up of a main aobao surrounded by twelve smaller ones. Aobao worship is a traditional Mongolian ritual, and here you can offer prayers and blessings for your family and friends.
- Then, visit Meidaizhao Monastery, also known as Shouling Temple, an important missionary center during the early spread of Lamaism into Mongolia. It is now a revered Tibetan Buddhist sanctuary. Its architecture showcases a distinctive style that combines Central Plains Han design with Mongolian and Tibetan influences. Inside the temple, the walls of the Buddha halls are covered with brilliantly colored, lifelike murals that possess great artistic value.
- After dinner, return to hotel for rest.
- Baotou Tianlong Hotel or similar

DAY 5 BAOTOU A DALAD BANNER

- After breakfast, proceed to Wudangzhao [Badekar Monastery], a Tibetan-style lamasery often referred to as the "Little Potala Palace". It is considered the leading Tibetan Buddhist monastery in Inner Mongolia and serves as a sacred pilgrimage site for Mongolian Buddhists. Alongside the Potala Palace in Tibet, Ta'er Monastery in Qinghai, and Labrang Monastery in Gansu, Wudangzhao is recognized as one of the four great lamaseries of Tibetan Buddhism.
- Continue the tour with a visit to Saihantala Park, a wetland ecosystem built to replicate the original grasslands within the city of Baotou. Also known as the Genghis Khan Grassland Ecological Park, it is the largest natural grassland area within the city.
- Next, visit Northern Weapon City, the first military-themed tourist attraction in North China. This unique park is built on principles of green ecology, with a focus on showcasing military industry culture while offering leisure and entertainment experiences.
- Dalad Banner Dongda Jinyuan Hotel or similar

[MOB] DAY 6 DALAD BANNER ₩ XIANGSHAWAN ₩ ORDOS

- After breakfast, depart for Xiangshawan, a desert resort destination [round-trip cableway ride included]. This vast desert features rolling sand dunes, picturesque crescent-shaped dune chains, rare ridge sands, and honeycomblike sand formations. Known as the "King of Singing Sands," Xiangshawan is a natural wonder. It is home to the world's first desert cableway, China's largest camel herd, and a top-tier ethnic art troupe. The mysterious phenomenon of the singing sands has puzzled people for centuries, giving rise to many beautiful legends.
- Next, head to the Genghis Khan's Mausoleum in Ordos. This is a cenotaph and symbolic memorial of Genghis Khan, the first Great Khan of the Mongol Empire. As an imperial tomb of great historical significance, it stands out with its stunning grassland surroundings, mysterious cultural landscapes, and deep ethnic heritage, showcasing the grandeur of a prairie emperor's resting place.
- After dinner, check into the hotel for the overnight stay in Ordos.
- Ordos Holiday Inn Express or similar

DAY 7 ORDOS HOHHOT

[B/L/D]

- After breakfast, take a bus to visit the Inner Mongolia Museum [closed on Mondays]. This museum combines strong modern elements, regional characteristics, and ethnic features. It serves as an "encyclopedia" of Northern China's history and is also a symbol of the region's economic and social development.
- In the afternoon, head to Genghis Khan Square to take photos with the statue of the legendary hero Genghis Khan, experiencing his indomitable spirit.
- Then, visit the General Government Office Museum of Inner Mongolia [closed on Mondays]. Built upon the Qing Dynasty Suiyuan General Office, this ancient architectural museum showcases the historical evolution, layout, local customs of Suiyuan City, and the urban development of Hohhot. It highlights its significant role in maintaining and consolidating China's northern border while promoting ethnic unity and integration.
- Stay overnight in Hohhot.
- Hohhot Huachen Lvyue Hotel or similar

DAY 8 HOHHOT

- After breakfast, visit Dazhao Temple, a large Tibetan Buddhist temple in the southern part of Yuquan District, Hohhot. It belongs to the Gelug sect and has a wide influence in the Mongolian region. The temple is also known as the "Silver Buddha Temple" because it enshrines a silver Buddha statue. Its magnificent architecture, precious cultural relics, and artworks form a unique cultural heritage.
- Next, explore Saishang Old Street, a historic street featuring Ming and Qing dynasty architectural styles.
- Visit the Zhaojun Museum in Yuquan District, Hohhot [closed on Mondays]. The museum consists of the Xiongnu Culture Museum, Zhaojun Tomb, Heqin Palace, and the Zhaojun Memorial Hall. Here, you can learn about the historical story of Zhaojun's journey to the frontier and the life of Wang Zhaojun, one of the Four Great Beauties of ancient China.
- After dinner, return to the hotel for another night stay.
- Hohhot Huachen Lvyue Hotel or similar

DAY 9 HOHHOT BEIJING

[B/D]

- After breakfast, head to the train station for high-speed train back to Beijing.
- Upon arrival, enjoy free time for sightseeing and shopping at Qianmen Street
- Enjoy dinner and check into the hotel for an overnight stay in Beijing.
- Beijing Beijing CSN Pearl Hotel or similar

DAY 10 BEIJING > KUALA LUMPUR

Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following conditions. The organizer shall be known as "The Company" in the conditions below.

RESERVATIONS AND DEPOSIT

A deposit of RM 500 - RM 3,000.00 (subject to tour package selected) is required upon booking. The balance is to be paid in full 35-40 days before departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of reservation and a forfeiture of deposit. Deposits are applicable for the tour booked only and are not transferable.

CREDIT CARD / CHARGE CARD

An administrative fee is chargeable for payments by credit or charge card.

CANCELLATION / AMENDMENTS

- 1) Cancellation of a confirmed booking must be made in writing to avoid misunderstanding.
- Postponement / transfer of tour will be deemed to be a cancellation and will be charged accordingly.
- Cancellations during peak, festive or holiday seasons will result in 100% forfeiture of the booking deposit.
- 4) For each amendment made after a booking has been confirmed, a fee will be charge by the respective airlines and service suppliers. An amendment does not constitute a transfer to another tour.
- 5) Deposits paid during travel fairs are non-refundable and will be forfeited if passenger cancels

TOUR FARE INCLUDES (GROUP TOURS ONLY)

Unless stated otherwise, the fare includes:-

CHILD FARE

Eligibility: Below 12 years (on the date of departure) Child fare is based on sharing a room with two adults. There will be an additional cost for child sharing one room with an adult.

ACCOMMODATION

In the event the accommodation booked or requested is not available, every effort will be made for an alternative accommodation of similar standard. The Company shall henceforth not bear any other liability or responsibility.

SPECIAL REQUEST

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

It is the passenger's responsibility to ensure that his/her international passport has a validity of at least 6 months from the date of departure. Relevant visas and vaccinations may be required. An administrative fee of RM50.00 per person will be levied for any cancellation due to non-approval of visas.

The Company will, wherever possible, assist you to obtain the necessary visas. Service charge and visa fees will be borne by the passenger. The Company does not guarantee the approval of the visa application. If for any reason, application for visa or exit permit is rejected, a full refund of all monies paid (excluding visa application fees) will be made, if the result of the rejection is made known to the Company at least 30 days prior to departures.

The Company cannot be held responsible for any expenses, reimbursement or refund of any tour fares if passenger is refused entry by any country on the tour for whatever reasons, including lack of necessary visas

SEAT ROTATION

For the convenience of all members of the group, passengers are requested to rotate their seating arrangements on the coach during the period of the tour. Please co-operate when called upon to do so by the tour leader/guide.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Strongly recommended with respect to such areas as trip cancellation, personal baggage, personal accident, injury and illness. Under no circumstance is The Company to be construed as a carrier under contract for safe carriage of the passenger or her/his baggage and belongings. Our staff will be pleased to assist in the enquiries of any travel insurance.

EXTENSION OF STAY / DEVIATION

Extension of stay / deviation may be permitted at the end of the tour, subject to validity and restrictions of air ticket, seat confirmation and availability of hotel prior to the commencement of tour. It is the passenger's responsibility to hold firm confirmation for their return flight. When extension of stay / deviation cannot be confirmed three weeks prior to the group's departure date, the passenger is deemed to be taking the original tour schedule. In the event that the original arrangement has been changed by The Company during the process, any extra cost will be borne by the passenger.

Extension of stay / deviation will be at the passenger's own expense and transfer to airport will not be provided. Alteration on the routing or date of travel is at the passenger's own risk. No refund will be made to such a person for unused air tickets or for any meals and sightseeing tours or accommodation not used in part or full.

The air ticket issued is a special ticket, restricted to a specific airline only. It is non-negotiable, non-endorsable, non-reissuable, non-refundable and non-reroutable.

RESPONSIBILITY

The Company acts only as an agent for the transportation companies, hotels and other principals for the tour programmes. They accept no responsibility for injuries, damage, accident, loss, delay, quarantine, theft, customs regulations, strikes, changes in itinerary, deportation or refusal of entry by Immigration Authorities resulting from improper travel documents, possession of unlawful items or irregularities that may be caused to person or property.
