DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR > CHENGDU

[MOB1

- Assemble at the airport for your flight to Chengdu, the capital city of Sichuan Province.
- Upon arrival, proceed to the hotel to check in for the overnight stay in Chengdu.
- Chengdu Tianfu International Hotel or similar

DAY 2 CHENGDU > LANZHOU

[B/MOB/D]

- After breakfast, head to the airport for the domestic flight to Lanzhou, Gansu Province.
- Upon arrival, visit the Yellow River Mother Statue. It is the most beautiful sculpture of the Yellow River that currently represent the Chinese nation by provided with a high artistic value.
- Visit the Lanzhou Waterwheel Park. The waterwheel is a water conservancy facility that uses the natural impact of the Yellow River water flow. It automatically lifts water to irrigate farmland through the rotation of the waterwheel.
- After dinner, enjoy the night view of the Yellow River Iron Bridge, the first bridge over the Yellow River, China's second longest river after Yangtze River.
- Enjoy a night stay in Lanzhou, the capital and largest city of Gansu Province.
- Lanzhou Parkside Hotel or similar class

LANZHOU 🖨 WUWEI

- After breakfast, visit Yellow River Hoodoo National Geopark [scenic area transportation included]. This ancient stone forest formation, which developed from sandstone and conglomerate layers millions of years ago, is a comprehensive geological park that combines natural landscapes with cultural history. It seamlessly integrates the ancient stone forest, the Yellow River, deserts, oases, gobi, and rural farms, offering a picturesque scene reminiscent of a paradise on earth.
- Enjoy a night stay in Wuwei.
- Wuwei Tianma Pearl Hotel or similar class

DAY 4 WUWEI 🛏 ZHANGYE

- After breakfast, visit Leitai Park, famous for the Chinese tourism symbol "Horse Treading on Flying Swallows" unearthed from the Leitai
- Next, visit the Danxia National Geopark [shuttle bus ride included]. The Danxia landforms are a masterpiece of nature. The colourful mountain ridges are just like an overturned palette from heaven.
- Enjoy dinner and a night stay in Zhangye.
- Zhangye Danxia Park Hotel or similar

ZHANGYE 🛏 JIUQUAN

- After breakfast, visit Jiuquan Park, a well-preserved classic garden with a history of over 2,000 years. The garden was constructed to be elegant and unsophisticated, including vigorous spring, waving lake, vivid sculpture and exquisite palaces.
- Next, visit Jiayuguan Gate Tower [shuttle bus ride included] an important pass and defensive tower in ancient times. The building is full of ancient characteristics, and the red exterior wall shows a magnificent momentum.
- Enjoy dinner and a night stay in Jiayuguan.

DAY 6 JIUQUAN 🖨 DUNHUANG

- After dinner, make your own way to Shazhou Night Market, the largest night market in Dunhuang. It's a hub for Silk Road cuisine and handicrafts, rich in local flavor and vibrant folk culture.
- Stay overnight in Dunhuang.

DAY 7 DUNHUANG

- In the morning, go on a guided tour of Mogao Grottoes [digital movie, shuttle bus ride, and cave entrance covered], also known as the Thousand Buddha Caves. Regarded as the largest Buddhist cave with the most abundant cultural relics in the world, it is well known for many colourful murals and a variety of vivid statues.
- Then, head to the Silk Road Heritage City [shuttle bus ride included + complimentary drone photography]. This site showcases cultural heritage and historical artifacts from along the Silk Road. Visitors can also gain insight into the hardships faced by ancient trade caravans and the historical process of cultural exchange between East and West.
- Enjoy another night stay in Dunhuang.
- Dunhuang Luye Hotel Dunhuang or similar class

DUNHUANG 🗕 LIUYUAN 🗢 TURPAN

- After breakfast, head to the popular photo spot and trendy destination Dunhuang Press, to experience hands-on DIY seal-making — the studio showcases a wide variety of seal artworks related to Dunhuana culture, offering a glimpse into the captivating charm of Dunhuang's artistic heritage...
- Next, proceed to the train station and take a train to Turpan.
- Enjoy the dinner and overnight stay in Turpan.
- Turpan Hampton by Hilton or similar

DAY 9 TURPAN 🗐 URUMQI

[B/L/D]

- After breakfast, proceed to the Flaming Mountains, renowned for their unique red and orange hues, which give them the appearance of being on fire, and immortalised in the classic Chinese novel Journey to the West.
- Next, learn about the Karez System, a remarkable underground irrigation network that has been used for centuries in the region which diverts underground water and turns the desert into an oasis.
- Then, visit Jiaohe Ancient City [shuttle bus ride included], the world's largest, oldest and best preserved earth building city with a history of more than two thousand years.
- Enjoy another night stay in Turpan.
- Urumqi Four Points by Sheraton or similar

DAY 10 URUMQI

- After breakfast, visit Tianshan Tianchi, a natural scenic spot renowned for its unique lakes and snow-capped mountains [shuttle bus + Buggy + boat ride included]. Dubbed "the Pearl of Tianshan Mountains", it is a toprated attraction in Xinjiang and a UNESCO World Natural Heritage site.
- Next, visit International Grand Bazaar, the largest bazaar in the world by scale, combining Islamic culture, architecture, ethnic commerce, tourism and entertainment. It is also one of the most famous landmarks in Xinjiang.
- Enjoy dinner and a night stay in Urumqi.
- Urumqi Four Points by Sheraton or similar

- After breakfast, return to Chengdu by flight.
- Upon arrival, stroll along Chengdu Kuanzhai Alley, a newly renovated ancient Qing Dynasty street in Chengdu, where you can taste local food, buy souvenirs and experience the local culture.
- Explore the historically rich Jinli Ancient Street in Chengdu, where numerous traditional buildings and cultural elements from the Ming and Qing dynasties have been preserved.
- After dinner, proceed to the airport for the departure flight home.

Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following conditions. The organizer shall be known as "The Company" in the conditions below.

RESERVATIONS AND DEPOSIT

A deposit of RM 500 - RM 3,000.00 (subject to tour package selected) is required upon booking. The balance is to be paid in full 35-40 days before departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of reservation and a forfeiture of deposit. Deposits are applicable for the tour booked only and are not transferable.

CREDIT CARD / CHARGE CARD

An administrative fee is chargeable for payments by credit or charge card.

CANCELLATION / AMENDMENTS

- 1) Cancellation of a confirmed booking must be made in writing to avoid misunderstanding.
- Postponement / transfer of tour will be deemed to be a cancellation and will be charged accordingly.
- 3) Cancellations during peak, festive or holiday seasons will result in 100% forfeiture of the booking deposit.
- 4) For each amendment made after a booking has been confirmed, a fee will be charge by the respective airlines and service suppliers. An amendment does not constitute a transfer to another tour.

If for any reason, application for visa or exit permit is rejected, a full refund of all monies paid (excluding visa application fees) will be made, if the result of the rejection is made known to the Company at least 30 days prior to departures.

The Company cannot be held responsible for any expenses, reimbursement or refund of any tour fares if passenger is refused entry by any country on the tour for whatever reasons, including lack of necessary visas.

SEAT ROTATION

For the convenience of all members of the group, passengers are requested to rotate their seating arrangements on the coach during the period of the tour. Please co-operate when called upon to do so by the tour leader/guide.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Strongly recommended with respect to such areas as trip cancellation, personal baggage, personal accident, injury and illness. Under no circumstance is The Company to be construed as a carrier under contract for safe carriage of the passenger or her/his baggage and belongings. Our staff will be pleased to assist in the enquiries of any travel insurance.

EXTENSION OF STAY / DEVIATION

Extension of stay / deviation may be permitted at the end of the tour, subject to validity and restrictions of air ticket, seat confirmation and availability of hotel prior to the commencement of tour. It is the passenger's responsibility to hold firm confirmation for their return flight.
