9 DAYS 7 NIGHTS EXPLORE MT. SIGUNIANG - CHENGDU / MT. SIGUNIANG / DANBA / HAILUOGOU [CTSS]

DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR > CHENGDU

- [MOB]
- Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for flight to Chengdu, capital of Sichuan province.
- Upon arrival, proceed to the hotel to check in for the overnight stay.
- ★ Chengdu Holiday Inn Express or similar

DAY 2 CHENGDU DUJIANGYAN MT. SIGUNIANG [B/L/D]

- > In the morning, visit the **Chuancais Museum**, a museum themed around the culture of Sichuan cuisine to learn about the origins, development, and evolution of Sichuan cuisine, and also taste some local food.
- > Leave Chengdu and head to Dujiangyan's Yangtianwo Square. The large panda selfie art sculpture here has become a must-visit spot and a new landmark of the city.
- Next, tour Guanxian Ancient Town next to the thousand-year-old Dujiangyan irrigation system. The magnificent Dujiangyan Nanqiao in the ancient city is grand and atmospheric, with an ancient and beautiful design, representing the typical Bashu architectural style.
- > Then, arrive at the **Maobiliang Viewing Platform**, a great spot to see the full view of Siguniang Mountain, as well as the sunrise and sunset. From Maobiliang, you can see Haizi Valley in the front and Siguniang Mountain in the back, providing a breathtaking view.
- > After dinner, stay overnight at Mt. Siguniang.

DAY 3 MT. SIGUNIANG A DANBA

[B/L/D]

- After breakfast, head to **Shuangqiaogou** in Mt. Siguniang, a fairyland-like place [shuttle bus included]. The valley is steep and winding, with intertwined mountains and waters, interspersed with vegetation, and shrouded in clouds and mist, making it mesmerizing. You can enjoy the beautiful scenery of places like Ginseng Fruit Ping, Long Zhucuo, Five-Colored Mountain, Nian Yuba, Sun Moon Treasure Mirror, Lieren Feng, Yingzui Peak, Redwood Forest Glacier, etc. These sights are like a series of picturesque galleries, making it hard to leave.
- ➤ Leave Mt. Siguniang and head to Jiaju Tibetan Village [buggy included] in Danba County. This Tibetan village is built on the mountainside and is a hidden paradise in the Hengduan Mountains. Ranked as the most beautiful of the six ancient rural towns in China, it boasts magnificent and charming landscapes, primitive and mysterious beauty, serene and poetic rural houses, and unique ancient stone watchtowers, all showcasing its charm.
- > Check in to the hotel in Danba after dinner.
- ★ Danba Danba Jimei Hotel or similar

DAY 4 DANBA 🛱 KANGDING

[B/I /D]

- After breakfast, head to **Moshi Park**, which boasts a rare geological wonder [buggy ride included]. Due to the calcium salts in the stone forest and the presence of crystallized water, the rocks change color with the seasons. During dry seasons, they appear light gray or light blue, while in humid seasons, they turn dark black. Alternatively, on the same day, the colors can change with the weather, creating a dynamic gem-like labyrinth. This mysterious and colorful world offers endless fascination and fun.
- Next, proceed to Tagong Grassland, one of the most charming grasslands in Ganzi Prefecture. In Tibetan, Tagong means "the place that Bodhisattvas like." Here, you will find enchanting natural scenery and a rich Tibetan cultural atmosphere. The grassland features the golden Muya Godlden Stupa, covered with gold foil, making it the most splendid sight. Nearby is the renowned Sakya Sect monastery, Tagong Temple, a magnificent and grand structure, serving as an important pilgrimage site for Tibetan Buddhism. Additionally, you should not miss the Yala Snow Mountain, one of the four sacred mountains in the Tibetan region, offering a magnificent and breathtaking view from afar.
- > Stay overnight in Kangding.
- ★ Kangding Kangding Love Song Hotel or similar

DAY 5 KANGDING A HAILUOGOU

[B/L/D]

- After breakfast, head to Mugecuo Scenic Area [Shuttle + buggy ride included], known as Yerenhai. Here, you'll find lakes, grasslands, snowcapped mountains and pristine forests, creating captivating landscape.
- Enjoy dinner and stay overnight at a local hotel in Hailuogou [Including one visit to the hotel's hot springs].
- * Hailuogou Gongga Cliff Hot Spring Hotel or similar

DAY 6 HAILUOGOU

[B/L/D]

- After breakfast, head to the Hailuogou Ice Falls [cable car and shuttle bus included]. Located at the upper end of the Hailuogou Glacier, this massive cliff features the Big Ice Waterfall, which stands 1,080 meters high and 1,100 meters wide. It is the tallest and largest ice waterfall, approximately 15 times the size of the Huangguoshu Waterfall. This immense solid ice waterfall seems to cascade from the blue sky like a galaxy and stands like a giant silver screen on the glacier.
- > After dinner, stay another night in Hailuogou.
- ★ Hailuogou Gongga Cliff Hot Spring Hotel or similar

DAY 7 HAILUOGOU A CHENGDU

[B/L/D]

- > After breakfast, leave Hailuogou for Chengdu.
- En route, visit the famous Luding Bridge, a more than 300 year old iron chain suspension bridge, esteemed as one of the marvels in ancient Chinese architectural history.
- Upon arriving in Chengdu, embark on the city tour. Take a leisurely stroll through the distinctive commercial street of Kuanzhai Alley, a Qing Dynasty Era Street recently renovated in Chengdu. Here you can savour different types of local specialties, buy souvenirs and immerse yourself in the local culture.
- > After dinner, check into the hotel in Chengdu.
- * Chengdu Minshan Hotel or simalar

DAY 8 CHENGDU > KUALA LUMPUR

[B/L/D]

- After breakfast, explore the historical rich Jinli Ancient Street in Chengdu, where numerous traditional buildings and cultural elements from the Ming and Qing dynasties have been preserved.
- Next, head to Eastern Suburbs Memory Park, also known as Chengdu East Music Park. This creative cultural park, transformed from an old industrial area, integrates music, art, and photography.
- Next, proceed to Chunxi Road Pedestrian Street, one of the most prosperous commercial streets in western China, a paradise for shopping enthusiasts.
- Explore **Taikoo Li** in the heart of Chengdu, an area characterized by traditional Sichuan–style architecture and an open and low-density shopping center layout, offering a unique shopping leisure experience.
- After dinner, proceed to the airport for your flight back to Kuala Lumpur.

Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following conditions. The organizer shall be known as "The Company" in the conditions below.

RESERVATIONS AND DEPOSIT

A deposit of RM 500 - RM 3,000.00 (subject to tour package selected) is required upon booking. The balance is to be paid in full 35-40 days before departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of reservation and a forfeiture of deposit. Deposits are applicable for the tour booked only and are not transferable.

CREDIT CARD / CHARGE CARD

An administrative fee is chargeable for payments by credit or charge card.

CANCELLATION / AMENDMENTS

- 1) Cancellation of a confirmed booking must be made in writing to avoid misunderstanding.
- Postponement / transfer of tour will be deemed to be a cancellation and will be charged accordingly.
- Cancellations during peak, festive or holiday seasons will result in 100% forfeiture of the booking deposit.
- 4) For each amendment made after a booking has been confirmed, a fee will be charge by the respective airlines and service suppliers. An amendment does not constitute a transfer to another tour.
- Deposits paid during travel fairs are non-refundable and will be forfeited if passenger cancels tour.

TOUR FARE INCLUDES (GROUP TOURS ONLY)

Unless stated otherwise, the fare includes:-

- Return economy class group tour air ticket.

- Hotel accommodation on twin-share or triple-share basis. Single room occupancy is at additional cost.

CHILD FARE

Eligibility: Below 12 years (on the date of departure) Child fare is based on sharing a room with two adults. There will be an additional cost for child sharing one room with an adult.

ACCOMMODATION

In the event the accommodation booked or requested is not available, every effort will be made for an alternative accommodation of similar standard. The Company shall henceforth not bear any other liability or responsibility.

SPECIAL REQUEST

If there are any requests regarding special meals, dietary requirements, adjoining rooms and so on, please inform The Company when booking. Such requests are subject to confirmation and availability.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

It is the passenger's responsibility to ensure that his/her international passport has a validity of at least 6 months from the date of departure. Relevant visas and vaccinations may be required. An administrative fee of RM50.00 per person will be levied for any cancellation due to non-approval of visas.

The Company will, wherever possible, assist you to obtain the necessary visas. Service charge and visa fees will be borne by the passenger. The Company does not guarantee the approval of the visa application. If for any reason, application for visa or exit permit is rejected, a full refund of all monies paid (excluding visa application fees) will be made, if the result of the rejection is made known to the Company at least 30 days prior to departures.

The Company cannot be held responsible for any expenses, reimbursement or refund of any tour fares if passenger is refused entry by any country on the tour for whatever reasons, including lack of necessary visas.

SEAT ROTATION

For the convenience of all members of the group, passengers are requested to rotate their seating arrangements on the coach during the period of the tour. Please co-operate when called upon to do so by the tour leader/guide.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Strongly recommended with respect to such areas as trip cancellation, personal baggage, personal accident, injury and illness. Under no circumstance is The Company to be construed as a carrier under contract for safe carriage of the passenger or her/his baggage and belongings. Our staff will be pleased to assist in the enquiries of any travel insurance.

EXTENSION OF STAY / DEVIATION

Extension of stay / deviation may be permitted at the end of the tour, subject to validity and restrictions of air ticket, seat confirmation and availability of hotel prior to the commencement of tour. It is the passenger's responsibility to hold firm confirmation for their return flight. When extension of stay / deviation cannot be confirmed three weeks prior to the group's departure date, the passenger is deemed to be taking the original tour schedule. In the event that the original arrangement has been changed by The Company during the process, any extra cost will be borne by the passenger.

Extension of stay / deviation will be at the passenger's own expense and transfer to airport will not be provided. Alteration on the routing or date of travel is at the passenger's own risk. No refund will be made to such a person for unused air tickets or for any meals and sightseeing tours or accommodation not used in part or full.

The air ticket issued is a special ticket, restricted to a specific airline only. It is non-negotiable, non-endorsable, non-reissuable, non-refundable and non-reroutable.

RESPONSIBILITY

The Company acts only as an agent for the transportation companies, hotels and other principals for the tour programmes. They accept no responsibility for injuries, damage, accident, loss, delay, quarantine, theft, customs regulations, strikes, changes in itinerary, deportation or refusal of entry by Immigration Authorities resulting from improper travel documents, possession of unlawful items or irregularities that may be caused to person or property.
